

## Location:

Bayreuth is located in north-eastern Bavaria and is known worldwide for its history and the Wagner Festivals. It is a young university town and is well-known among international geoscientists for its state-of-the-art Bavarian Geoinstitute of Experimental Geochemistry and Geophysics.

Bayreuth can be reached easily by air, train or car:

- By air via Frankfurt (280 km), Munich (220 km), and/or Nuremberg (80 km) continuing by train or by car.
- By train via Nuremberg (from north, northwest, west and south) or Marktredwitz (from northeast and east).
- Bayreuth is located at the main Autobahn A9 (E 21 route Nuremberg Hof Leibzig Berlin) about 80 km northeast of Nuremberg.
